About the Consortium

The Bronx Health and Housing Consortium organized in 2011 with the purpose of establishing a collaborative network of providers in the Bronx with the shared goal of streamlining client access to health care and quality housing. The Consortium is comprised of representatives from health, housing, social service, governmental agencies, and four Health Homes in the Bronx. The Consortium gained momentum following the implementation of Health Homes as the partner agencies felt an urgent need to increase communication, collaboration, and their shared goal of improving health outcomes for their enrolled clients.

The Consortium's work includes planning and advocating for services to support Bronx residents and helping to further the ability of our member agencies to collaborate to provide access to quality health care and housing in the Bronx. Since our founding in 2011, the Consortium has grown in both size and scope, with over 40 partner organizations and government agencies and has gained the reputation of getting things done. The following are some of the initiatives we are working on, along with who to contact if you want to get involved:

- A series of **Housing Marketplaces** for Health Home care coordinators to meet with representatives from housing providers, learn about vacancies, and make referrals; the second Marketplace is on January 29 and will focus on seniors;
